

### **ANY3: Anyone, Anywhere, Anytime Gospel Bridge**

1. **GET TO THE POINT:** What religion do you follow? (or What's your worldview?)
  - a. Are you Hindu, Buddhist, Muslim, Ancestor, State Church worshiper?
  - b. ["All religions are the same!" Yes, we are trying to deal with our sin/merit/spiritual problem.]
  
2. **GET THEM LOST:** In your religion, how do you get your sins forgiven/paid off? [Make enough merit; appease the spirits; etc?]
  - a. So how's that going for you?
  - b. Are they paid off yet? [When will you have made enough merit?]
  - c. [Will they be paid off on judgment day? How many lifetimes will it take to reach Nirvana?]
  
3. **GET TO THE GOSPEL:** Hmm, well what I believe is a bit different. I know my sins have been forgiven [OR, "God has broken the cycle of me having to make enough merit; OR "I've found freedom from the harassment of spirits."]
  - a. Not because I'm a good person -- you are probably a better person than I am!
  - b. I want to share with you how I know I have been forgiven. Share your story and God's story.
  - c. After sharing the story, ask if they want to meet again to hear more stories.
  - d. If the Holy Spirit leads, invite them to enter God's kingdom through repentance and faith.
  
4. **GET TO DISCIPLESHIP:** If they do not enter God's kingdom but are willing to meet again, follow up with the Seven Stories of Hope.
