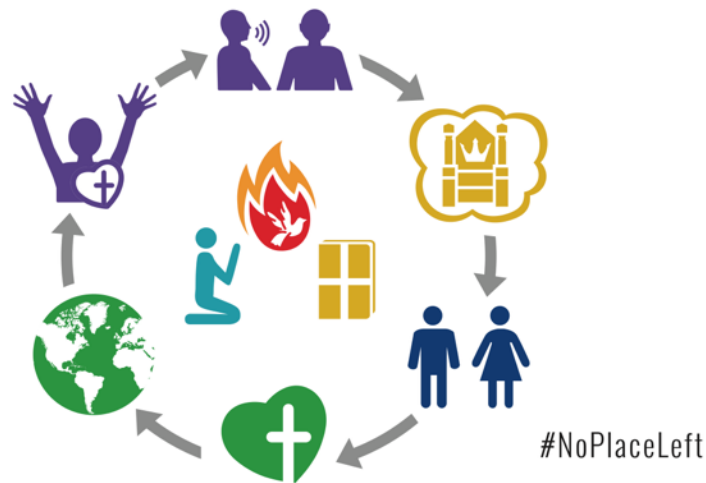
### Bible Story Discussion Set

## Bible Story Discussion: Instructions & Questions



### Bible Story Discussion Instructions



1. **Blue Icon:** Person Praying: Sing songs, encourage each other & pray.
2. **Red Icon:** Holy Spirit - Ask the Holy Spirit to speak and reveal truth.
3. **Gold Icon:** Bible Story - Discuss a Bible story. Obey Jesus' commands. Make a plan to share hope with others.



1. **Purple Icon:** Hands Raised: How did you abide in and obey Jesus last week?
2. **Purple Icon:** Person Speaking: How did you share the gospel last week?
3. **Gold Icon:** Throne/Crown/Cloud: What does this Bible story teach us about God?
4. **Blue Icon:** Man & Woman: What does this Bible story teach us about people?
5. **Green Icon:** Heart & Cross: How will I abide in and obey Jesus this week?
6. **Green Icon:** The World: Who will hear this story from me next week?

**Key Leadership Goal:** Leaders, remember to facilitate the work of the Holy Spirit in the discipleship gathering rather than develop a dependence upon you and your ability to teach the Bible. **Model, Assist, Watch, and Leave.** (2 Timothy 2:2; Hebrews 5:11-14)
